Any student who has graduated from or is currently attending an ACI-member college or university is welcome to participate in the [Hispanic Alliance for Career Enhancement \(HACE\) Virtual Career Fair](#) Thursday, Sept. 29, from 2 p.m. CDT to 5 p.m. CDT. Employers participating in the online career fair will offer opportunities for both internships and jobs for students and entry-level professionals.

[HACE](#), with a network of 85,000 members across the country, is a national nonprofit dedicated to employment, development and advancement of current and aspiring Latino professionals.

Participants' resumes should be uploaded before the event so employers have information readily available. At the career fair, participants will choose employers to interact with and engage in a one-on-one chat with a recruiter. Participants should be prepared to share personal background information, work experience and ask questions of potential employers.
