Associated Colleges of Illinois has set dates for three spring <u>conferences</u>, aimed at supporting faculty and staff at its <u>23 member Illinois colleges and universities</u>.

The conferences, aimed at increasing the effectiveness and efficiency of liberal arts higher education in the state, will be held in April:

April 4, Student Engagement Conference, <u>Augustana College</u> (Rock Island): This conference is intended for faculty and staff who work with low-income, minority and first-generation students at member colleges and universities. Attendees are deans of students, financial aid officers, career services professionals, multicultural officers and others.

April 11, Advancement Conference, <u>North Park University</u> (Chicago): This conference is for advancement and fundraising professionals of member institutions.

April 15, Chief Financial Officers, Millikin University (Decatur): This conference is intended for senior-level and chief financial officers of member institutions.

In addition, a forum for <u>presidents</u> of ACI members will be held at a location and date to be determined.
