Foundation Grants Awarded to ACI

Grants were awarded this summer to ACI from three foundations, including CME Group Foundation, ITW Foundation and McGraw Foundation.

ITW Foundation, Glenview, Illinois, awarded \$10,000 for ACI's Peer Mentoring Program. The program operates on 11 ACI-member campuses. It works to help first-generation, low-income students through the critical first year in college, and helps them remain in

college and earn degrees.

The McGraw Foundation, Dundee, Illinois, is a longtime partner with ACI. It awarded \$95,000 to ACI, which provides the funds to member colleges and
