PRSA Chicago Chapter Recognizes ACI for Communication Work June 18, 2019



PRSA Chicago recognized ACI's work in three communication awards categories -- annual report, student video series and digital newsletter.

The Public Relations Society of America's (PRSA) Chicago chapter presented three awards to Associated College of Illinois (ACI) for its work in communication in 2018. ACI was one of the few nonprofit organizations to win multiple awards this year. Awards were presented June 13 in Chicago.

Skyline Awards – top awards in their categories – were presented to ACI for its 2018-2018 annual report and for its student stories video series, featuring scholarship recipients and Peer Mentoring Program participants. The video

series won in the "Shoe String Budget" category, for projects produced with very limited budgets.

In addition, the organization's digital newsletter, <u>ACI Reporter</u>, was presented an Award of Excellence, given to high-scoring entries.

ACI previously was presented an Award of Excellence by PRSA Chicago for its 2015-2016 annual report.
